SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LAND ^{NOT} OF EASTERN PULPWOOD
CORPORATION; THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING
RUNNING AT RIGHT ANGLES TO SAID HIGHWAY, NORTH 21°
30' EAST BY OTHER LAND OF GRANTOR, ONE HUNDRED (100)
FEET TO ANOTHER IRON PIPE OR PIN SET IN THE GROUND;
THENCE TURNING AND RUNNING NORTH 68°30' WEST
